ALEJANDRO BULGHERONI ESTATE 2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY

Our flagship wine, this cuvée puts on display the blending mastery of Michel Rolland and Philippe Melka. Each year, we identify our best lots and barrels to create something never before made, unique to the vintage, and never to be repeated. What we consider the wine of the vintage from our cellar - the Alejandro Bulgheroni Cabernet Sauvignon.

TASTING NOTES

Pronounced aromatics of blueberry, dark cherry, violets, and spring flowers give way to notes of tobacco, toasted bread, and graphite. Full bodied-richness and power are allied with the trademark weightless, elegant texture this wine always seems to deliver. The tannins are plush yet precise, and frame the wine beautifully. Our last three vintages delivered 98, 99 and 100 point scores, and we feel this is our best effort to date.

WINEMAKING

20-28 day fermentations in 69% oak and 31% stainless steel tank. Aged 22 months in 72% new French oak barriques.

WINEMAKERS: Matt Sands, Philippe Melka, and Michel Rolland.

VARIETAL: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon.
10% Cabernet Franc.

HARVESTED: September 9th and 29th.

BOTTLED: October 7th, 2023.

VINEYARD: Oakville 51%, St Helena 49%



“A flagship best barrel selection, the 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon Alejandro Bulgheroni checks in as 90% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Cabernet Franc from a mix of Oakville and St. Helena fruit that spent 22 months in 72% new barrels. It’s another inky-hued, glass-staining wine revealing incredible aromatics of pure crème de cassis, black raspberries, flowery incense, new leather, and chocolate. These all carry to a full-bodied, flawlessly balanced, utterly heavenly 2021 that has ripe, polished tannins, no hard edges, incredible purity, and a great, great finish. finish. It needs 4-5 years to show its full potential but will be a 30+ year wine.”
