TASTING NOTES

Our Dr. Crane Cab represents the epitome of balance and gracefulness. The trademark lifted, floral nose, with blue fruits accented with berries, earth and spice, leads into a palate that walks the line of vibrancy and power, delicacy aligned with richness and depth, and is our most beguiling, and truly elegant, wine.

VINEYARDS

Perfectly situated on the west side of Saint Helena with Sulphur Creek running along its northern border, the Dr. Crane vineyard is the perfect example of how gravely, free-draining, benchland soils produce some of the most compelling, age-defying wines in all of Napa Valley. These wines are elevated, high-toned, and extraordinarily complex.

WINEMAKING

Fermented un 81% Oak, and 19% stainless for 25 days.
Aged for 22 months in 78% new french oak.

WINEMAKERS: Matt Sands, Philippe Melka, and Michel Rolland.

VARIETAL: 92% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 8% Cabernet Franc.

HARVESTED: September 14th, 2021.

BOTTLED: July 2023.

CASE PRODUCTION: 88 cases.

ALCOHOL: 14.9%

AVA: St. Helena.

VINEYARD: Beckstoffer, Dr. Crane.
